Storage	Store prefilled syringes in freezer between -50°C and -15°C (-58°F and 5°F) until expiration. After thawing, store in refrigerator between 2°C and 8°C (36°F and 46°F) for up to 60 days or until expiration date printed on carton, whichever comes first. May be stored between 8°C and 25°C (46°F and 77°F) for up to 12 hours. Protect vaccine from light. Do not refreeze once thawed.	Store unpunctured vials in ULT unit between -90°C and -60°C until expiration or in refrigerator between 2°C and 8°C (36°F and 46°F) for up to 10 weeks or between 8°C and 25°C (46° and 77°F) for up to 12 hours. Protect vaccine from light. Do not refreeze once thawed. Do not store vials between -25°C and -15°C (-13°F and 5°F).
